If you are attending camp on Friday

Please bring all of your clearly labeled overnight gear (sleeping bag, tent, etc.) with you on the bus Friday morning. **REMEMBER...PACK YOUR GEAR SEPARATELY FROM YOUR REGULAR CAMP BAG-** you will not be able to get into your gear until after the regular camp day ends.

If you are not attending camp on Friday

You may still attend the campout! Parents, please drop off your children with their gear at our main area between 4:00-4:15. Our counselors will be there to assist with your check-in.

What to bring.....

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All campers will need an outdoor, water-resistant sleeping bag and a pillow; warm clothes (long pants and jacket/sweatshirt); swimsuit and towel; extra clothes for Saturday morning; and all toiletries including toothbrush/toothpaste.

Other optional equipment includes a tent and a flashlight. While many of our campers sleep in tents, sleeping under the stars is an encouraged option. We ask that you consider sending no larger than a three person tent.

CAMP KEYSTONE OVERNIGHT CAMPOUT POLICIES



All campers and parents must be aware of the following rules and regulations for the upcoming campout. Please read carefully as some of our policies have changed. Due to the popularity of our overnights, no exceptions will be made to any of the following policies.

- 1) All registration forms, policy agreements, and payments must be submitted by Friday, Aug. 4th at 10AM. Parents sending their campers on the bus in the morning MUST hand the registration form to the bus supervisor with payment. Parents must see that a camp employee receives ALL registration forms by 10 AM Friday.
- 2) In an effort to preserve the true nature of camping under the stars, no cell phones may be brought to the campout for any reason.
- 3) Due to the number of campers spending the night, blow up air mattresses are not allowed.
- 4) Campers with specific dietary needs must supply their own food, clearly labeled. If refrigeration is required for meals, please see first aid specialist Friday morning. Please see the dinner list on the front to determine if this is applicable to your child.
- 5) Campers not attending camp on Friday must arrive between 4:00 and 4:15 on Friday afternoon. You will be directed where to park for drop off.
